Help managing your finances

Residents from Barne Barton and the wider St Budeaux community can continue to receive financial support through our local financial inclusion project.

The project helps residents who need support managing their finances by:

- providing support for those moving home
- providing advice and support to those struggling to maintain their tenancy – this includes help with utilities, benefits, and also to secure grants for essential household items
- signposting to other Homemaker projects for special support around benefit appeals and debts.

With the festive season upon us, we are aware of the extra financial pressure some residents may be facing and would encourage anyone who may be worried to speak to us about the help we can provide.
